For our newer (*and older*) members, here's a little helpful explanation. Annually, a Past Exalted Ruler from the District (ours being the South District) is appointed as liaison between the Lodges of the District and the Grand Lodge, thus the title DISTRICT DEPUTY GRAND EXALTED RULER (DDGER). This year's
